BRATWURST:

BRATWURST IS A SAUSAGE WITH PORK IN IT. IT IS ROASTED.

Here the rivers Röhre and Möhne flow into the Ruhr.



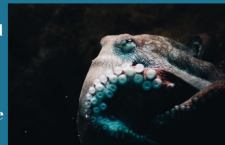
The mayor of the city of Arnsberg is Ralf Paul Bittner.
